
Venue : Conference Hall of the Deputy Commissioner, Hojai, Sankardev Nagar.

PWD (Roads)	Assessment of roads	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Chair instructed the Departments of PWD (Roads) and Water resources to jointly inspect the 65 kms stretch of embankments and roads in areas of Hawaipur, Raikata, Waregeding, Hayong Basti and Jamunamukh. After proper inspection, they are directed to submit a formal proposal for construction of high roads and embankments to mitigate floods in future. The Chair also instructed the EE, PWD (Roads) to recast the estimate of Asom Mala in flood affected areas on the basis of the recent flood experience. 	EE, PWD (Roads) and EE, Water resources.
