1. **PNRD DEPARTMENT** : During the field survey , the official of the PNRD Department point out the importance and proposed various schemes which are required for development of roads construction of Toran , upgradation of cremation ground ,installation of solar light, construction of footpath at daily market ,supply of boat at fishery pond at Jurapukhuri Adraxo Gram . The expenditure of the schemes will be borne by Axom Adarxo Gram yojana. The details are enclosed . The work of child park , play ground and library at the village will be done by PNRD department.
2. **PWD DEPARTMENT** : During the survey of the village PWD department points out the importants of two roads construction and proposed (1) Road construction from NH-54 to Litton Das House and (2)Road const from Hojai-Jurapukhuri road to Pmagaon PMGSY Road 500 Mtr. The Expenditure of this schemes will be borne by PWD Department
3. **FISHERY DEPARTMENT** : On the basis of meeting held on 03-08-21 a baseline survey was conducted and during the survey we point out some importance .There are two large fishery pond exist at Jurapukhuri village . So the People of the village will be benefited by composite fish culture activity . An advantage of composite fish culture is that it increases the yield of fish. Nearly five or six different species are grown together in a single fish pond. The several rate of fish increases and their yield also increases without effecting the other species . At the time of Fishing Boats are required at Jurapukhuri Fish Pond.
4. **PHE DEPARTMENT**: During the Field Survey the PHED points out that there is no pure water supply facility at Jurapukhuri village . A dormant water pipeline is available at the village . Sufficient pure Drinking water supply facility doesn't exist. Repairing and extension of water pipeline is required . Besides Safe Drinking water facilities are also required . During the survey the PHED found that sanitation facility is not available at the village . Proper sanitation facilities(for example-Toilet and Urinal) promote health because they allow people to dispose of their waste appropriately. So PHED proposes Some community Toilet should be constructed at Various public place of Jurapukhuri village.

- 5. **EDUCATION DEPARTMENT:** The BEEO Lanka proposed development of school infrastructure of Jurapukhuri LP School . It needs to Construction of 80 mts long Boundary Wall, Construction of Two Class Rooms and One Head Master Room etc.
- 6. **AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT :** The Department of Agriculture proposes various Schemes for the upliftment of Agriculture in the village .The proposed schemes will be funded from RKVY/BGREI/NESM .The Department also proposed to supply Tractor and Spray Machine to the Farmers of Jurapukhuri Village.
- 7. **SOCIAL WELFARE:** The social welfare Department under the ICDS proposed construction/ repairing of various Anganwadi centre.
- 8. **HELTH DEPARTMENT :** The department of Health proposed to develop the Jurapukhuri Helth Sub-Centre.
