1. **PWD Roads**:- During the field survey of Mikirati Hawgaon Adarsha Gaon on 29/7/2021 the PWD department proposed construction of a Road from NH -36 to Habigaon Irrigation canal costing about Rs. 200.00 Lacs (Rupees. Two Hunderd Lacs) Which will be beared by the PWRD.
2. **PHED**:- The officials of PHED after field survey proposed a multi village Scheme (MVS) to cover all the habitations under Mikirati Hawgaon village by providing functional house hold tap connection (FHTC) by retrofitting the existing Mikirati Hawgaon PWSS which is at the verge of completion. Installation of 150 m.m diameter has been done at the scheme. PHED also proposed 22 nos of IHHL. A community Managed Sanitary Complex (CMSC) is under construction. Expenditure of all these schemes will borne by the PHED.
3. **P&RD Department**:- The officials of P&RD Department proposed various schemes. Which are required for development of various rural Roads and other infrastructure of Mikirati Hawgaon Adarsha Gaon. The expenditure of all these schemes will be borne by MGNREGA. But Installation of 40 nos Solar Light & 1 nos of Bricks Road to be funded from Axom Adarsha Gram Yojana . The details are enclosed.
4. **Health**:-The Health Department proposed a health sub Center Building and also Boundary wall. The details are enclosed.
5. **Social Welfare**:- The Social Welfare Department proposed Construction/ Repairing of Various Anganwadi Center . The details are enclosed.
6. **APDCL**:- During the field survey, the APDCL proposed various items required for electrification of all the houses . The details are enclosed.
7. **Education**:- The Education department proposed development of various infrastructure and furnitures for Habigaon LP School, Sankardev LP School, Mikirati Hawgaon L.P School & Mikirati Hawgaon Adarsha M.E School. The details are enclosed.
8. **Irrigation Department** :- Department of Irrigation stated that TW ( Solar Powered) is a scheme on going under PMKSY (PH-I) at the village. The department also proposed TW (Electrical Operated ) under PMKSY . The Expenditure of all these scheme will be borne by Irrigation Department.
9. **Agriculture Department**:- The department of Agriculture proposed various schemes the upliftment of Agriculture in the village . Their proposed Schemes will be funded from RKVY/BGREI/NFSM. The details are enclosed.
